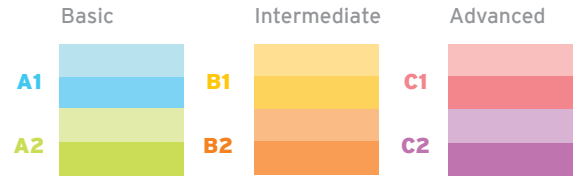


# BrainPOP ESL's Alignment to European Standards

The **Common European Framework** of Reference for Languages (CEF) provides a common basis for describing language learning, teaching, and assessment around the world. It describes what language learners can do at six specific levels: **A1, A2, B1, B2, C1, and C2**. These levels (A, B, and C) correspond to the general concepts of basic, intermediate, and advanced. The following document illustrates the ways BrainPOP ESL's three levels align to the CEF.
